Bruce Cuthbert, PhD is a Professor in the Clinical Science and Psychopathology Research program at the Department of Psychology, University of Minnesota-Twin Cities; prior to this appointment, he was on the faculty at the University of Florida and also was a program official at NIMH for seven years where he served as Chief of the Adult Psychopathology and Prevention Research Branch. The goal of Dr. Cuthbert's research is to develop new psychophysiological models and measures of affective processes, and to employ the findings in translational studies directed at an improved understanding of mood and anxiety disorders. The long-term goal of the research program is to explain these internalizing disorders in terms of interactions among the major motivational systems of the brain.
