Dr. Havlik has over 40 years of experience in cardiovascular disease, genetic, and aging epidemiology, and has published extensively in the measurement and validation of hypertension and blood pressure levels; and the assessment of medical history, cholesterol, and cognitive impairment. He has been actively involved in population-based epidemiological studies such as the Framingham Heart Study, the Puerto Rico Heart Health Programs, the National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey: Epidemiologic Follow-up Study, and the Honolulu-Asia Aging Study.
