Walter Koroshetz, MD is Deputy Director of the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke. Prior to coming to NIH he was Professor of Neurology at the Mass General Hospital, Harvard Medical School in Boston. There he directed the Stroke and Neurointensive Care Service. Over his career Dr. Koroshetz has worked as a basic neurobiology investigator, clinical researcher in neuroprotection for stroke, head trauma and Huntington's disease. He has been especially interested in MR imaging as an indicator for therapeutic intervention.
